CARE SERVICE EMPLOYEES – Residential Care

Selection Criteria

Applications should include a resume and a covering letter that details your claims against each of the following selection criteria:

1. Evidence of your interest in and concern for elderly people,
2. The ability to be flexible and adapt to changing needs
3. The ability to problem solve
4. The ability to work independently and to accept a level of autonomy
5. The ability to work effectively in a work team
6. Basic knowledge of needs of person living with dementia
7. Past experience of providing care to elderly people in a personal or work situation will be well regarded
8. The successful completion of a Certificate III in Aged Care is desirable but not essential.

To be eligible to apply for this position you must be an Australian Citizen or have an appropriate Australian or New Zealand work visa.

Please note that in December 2006 the Federal Government amended the Aged Care legislation making it compulsory for all people working in Aged Care to have a current Criminal History Record Check. If you do not have a current Criminal History Record Certificate (i.e. issued within the last three years) you will need to complete the appropriate form and lodge at your local police station. (A copy of the appropriate form can be found in the Employment section on our website).
